



For immediate release: In her new book, *The Life She Once Knew: The Incredible True Story of Queena, The Bloomingdale Library Attack Survivor* (Ambassador International; \$16.99; November 10, 2020), Vanna Nguyen shares the raw details of the horrific tragedy that changed her daughter's life—and ultimately hers as well—forever.

On April 24, 2008, Queena left work a healthy, happy senior, ready to graduate high school and finally spread her wings in a new world. But before the night was over, Queena would never be the same again. After being viciously attacked and left for dead by a teenage boy who was waiting for an unsuspecting victim, Queena's life hung in the balance. Queena suffered severe brain damage, leaving many medical professionals to give up hope on her.

“My life shifted from feeling normal to being utterly scared out of my mind,” writes Nguyen. “The ‘me’ I knew disappeared forever. Something horrible happened. My teenage daughter Queena looked into the eyes of evil—just as I had decades earlier. She fought with all her might for her right to live. Ultimately, she was victorious, but she would never be the same Queena. Our entire family changed as we muddled through the aftermath of an unspeakable crime. Over the course of twenty-five horrific minutes, we lost Queena—not to death, but to a new life no one was prepared to face.”

Follow Nguyen's story of faith, hope, and love as she recounts her own escape from the “life she once knew” in Vietnam to a life of freedom and possibilities in America. And be encouraged—as many who have already been following Queena's story have been—to see how precious every life is and how love truly can conquer all.

About the Book

In 1981, a young woman faced death as she lay on the floor of a small boat in the South China Sea fleeing the life she once knew in Vietnam.

In 2008, her teenage daughter lay fighting for her life after being brutally raped and abandoned while returning books at a library near Tampa, Florida.

The attack in front of the Bloomingdale library left Queena with a traumatic brain injury, sentenced to a life unable to walk, see, or speak. As Vanna Nguyen lovingly poured herself into caring for her now severely disabled daughter, she also battled with reliving her own Vietnam War survival story. And she must decide, can she forgive the attacker whose unforgivable decision changed both their lives as they knew them forever?

In *The Life She Once Knew*, Vanna candidly chronicles the deeply spiritual and emotionally powerful journeys of these two strong women as they fight for their lives and their futures decades apart.

About the Author

Vanna Nguyen is a refugee from South Vietnam and the mother of the Bloomingdale Library Attack Survivor, Queena. She devotes her life to Queena's full-time care and advocates for special needs and justice for victims of domestic, sexual, and physical abuse. She lives in Florida with her partner, Robert; Queena; and her two Shih Tzu dogs, Charlie and Princess. Her other daughter, Anna, lives nearby with her husband, Jonathan.

As a young child, Vanna Nguyen enjoyed a prestigious life in South Vietnam until the country's fall to Communism in 1975. After risking her life for the dream of freedom, she fled to the United States where she became a citizen and raised her two daughters, Anna and Queena. Life was perfect until 18-year-old Queena was brutally attacked and raped while dropping books off at the local library. As a result of the attack, Vanna lost not only her once-thriving small business, but she also lost her beloved daughter as she knew her.
